ARTIST STATEMENT REVERING NATURE

From 2006 to 2008, I served in the Peace Corps/Macedonia and in order to bring the art I made there home, I had to devise a way it could all be packed simply. Thus, the multiple pieces of paper which could be returned to a folio and carried in my suitcase! This approach allowed me to work on a large scale for the drama and interest it evokes. I had my first exhibition of the big tree drawings, there were five then, just before leaving service at the Struga, Macedonia, Art Museum in 2008.

Since coming home, I have continued with the multi-piece drawings as I find that approach gives the big works an appealing liveliness and movement. Keeping them unframed, but mounted on backings, in groups of several per backing, allows for portability and storage.

Trees have been the subjects of my work for many years. I develop my format from photos I've taken of trees from different parts of the world to my own yard! I want to bring the viewer's focus up close to examine shadows and texture for an intimate visual experience. The work shown here reflects my admiration and deep affinity for trees. My constant message is to remind the viewer of their importance to all living things - our world. They are great healers, as everyone who has walked amongst them, hugged one for blessing or comfort, enjoyed their shade and their voices can attest to.

About the pieces in this show:

The Nest is a tree in a park in England near the home my family had in St. Albans. It is among the trees I photographed when my daughter-in-law took me for a lovely walk. I loved the structure of the upper branches how they seemed to form a protected area, nest-like. In interpreting the image I was surprised to see how abstract my drawing became.

"Art happens in between what the eye sees and the hand produces!"

"UP" is a cedar tree I pass in one of the walks around my own neighborhood. It is behind a fence and one day I was inspired to look UP and this is what I saw. I love the patterns made when you are able to look up into our big cedars. Have you done this?
