Juliet Shen was born and raised in New York City and has resided in Seattle since 1983. After working in local design firms for eight years, she opened Shen Design, eventually concentrating on typeface design. Projects of note included a font for Lushootseed based on traditional Salish aesthetic sensibilities; a font for Oxford University Press early childhood education publications; and a collaboration with Sakkal Design to produce a multi-lingual font harmonizing the Arabic and Latin alphabets.

Juliet studied oil painting as a child with Dick Ralph and in the 1960s with Richard Mayhew, as well as attending the Cooper Union School of Art in the 70s. Joining the Duwamish River Artists Residency in 2012 prompted her return to painting full time. She closed the design firm in 2012 and retired from teaching typography in 2015. Juliet currently works with Chinese brush and ink, watercolor inks and acrylics. Her paintings have been acquired by Tacoma Art Museum, and the portable art collections of Portland, Oregon, Seattle Public Utilities, King County, 2+U and Horizon House.



"My work is about the life-affirming transformations I observe in nature: new life arising from decay; resilience to catastrophe; surface chaos masking underlying unison. I paint on paper every stroke leaving a mark that can't be undone—much like the effect of human actions on the environment. I believe the natural cycle of life and death is benevolent and therefore intrinsically moral. We alienate ourselves from nature at our own moral peril.

My *Transient Chaos* series is based on multidirectional water currents and their patterns of resolution. *Transient Chaos 6*, included in this show, was inspired by the saltwater lagoons of Ebey's Landing on Whidbey Island."
